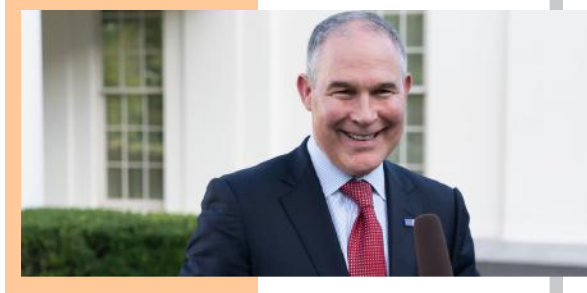


# TIMELINE OF TRUMP'S WAR ON CHILDREN'S HEALTH



**FEB. 17, 2017:**

Senate confirms Scott Pruitt as first Trump EPA administrator.

**MARCH 29, 2017:**

Pruitt cancels scheduled ban on neurotoxic pesticide chlorpyrifos.



**OCT. 10, 2017:**

Pruitt repeals Clean Power Plan, policy estimated to save thousands of lives and prevent hundreds of thousands of asthma attacks by 2030.

**DEC. 20, 2017:**

EPA delays ban on TCE, ingredient in aerosol degreasers and spot cleaners linked to cancer and especially harmful to children.



**FEB. 27, 2018:**

EPA closes office that studies impact of toxic chemicals on children.



**JUNE 20, 2018:**

After federal toxics agency says EPA's PFAS recommendation much too high, states set lower limits but EPA does nothing.



**JULY 6, 2018:**

After scandals force Pruitt's resignation, Andrew Wheeler appointed EPA acting administrator.

**AUG. 21, 2018:**

Trump administration unveils Clean Power Plan replacement, letting coal states set their own pollution rules.



**SEP. 25, 2018:**

EPA seeks to reverse court order reinstating chlorpyrifos ban.



**SEP. 26, 2018:**

Wheeler abruptly dismisses EPA top children's health official.



**SEP. 30, 2018:**

Wheeler proposes scrapping rule to reduce mercury pollution from coal plants.

**OCT. 3, 2018:**

White House deletes children's health language from draft EPA climate-change rule.
